### CAGLE ANNOUNCES 9 MILLION IN CAREER ACADEMY GRANTS HOLD THE DATE July 1st Workshop Planned

Lieutenant Governor Casey Cagle is proud to announce that for the fourth year the Technical College System of Georgia will be soliciting grant applications. This year there is \$9 million in bond funding available for Career Academy Grants. The Lt. Governor and the TCSG are encouraging schools, businesses, and community leaders to form partnerships and apply for a Career Academy in their area.

Over the last few years, these grants have been instrumental in expanding the number of Career Academies statewide. Since 2006, over twenty communities have received much needed start-up and equipment funding via the grant process. Today we have career academies across the state that are providing specialized career pathways and increased relevance in their coursework for Georgia's high school students.

As in previous years, the TCSG will manage the grant process. To help applicants with their grants, there will be a Career Academy Grant Application Workshop to cover information about the grant writing process, provide information about the Charter Application Process, share knowledge about Ford HUB resources, and answer important questions regarding deadlines and accounting details.

The TCSG will hold the training session at their offices in Atlanta on July 1 starting at 9AM and concluding around lunchtime. Additionally, TCSG will be broadcasting the training session to several technical colleges across the state via the Tandberg/Polycom Communication systems.
